This is a demonstration of the "PAP" method (Price and Probability), which is fully explained in Ray Gordon's book "Price and Probability." This sample sheet includes free ratings and selections.

KEY:
Rating = Power rating (top horse in race is 100)
No. = Program number
Value = Ray's morning line
ML = Program morning line
Open = Horse's opening odds
5M = Odds at five minutes to post (user input)
1M = Odds at one minute to post (user input)

Picks: Ray's picks for the race, expressed as a "handicapping opinion." Opinion structure is as follows: a "slash" (/) represents a clear choice over the next horse/tier, while a dash (-) represents a mild choice. Example opinions:

1/2-3/4 (#1 wins, #2-3 fight for second, #4 fourth).
 1-2/3/4 (#1-2 fight to win, #3 third, #4 fourth)
 1-2-3/4 (#1-2-3 fight to win, #4 fourth)
 1-2-3-4 (#1-2-3-4 all fight to win)
 1/2-3-4 (#1 wins, #2-3-4 fight for second)

You generally want your wagers to reflect the opinion. If you like 1/2-3-4, that would be reflected by keying #1 over #2-3-4, whereas if the opinion is 1-2-3-4, you might box all four horses (if you want to spend the money). If the opinion is 1/2/3-4, you might box #1-2, play 1-2/3-4, etc. Extra horses (beyond three tiers or five horses) are listed in case of scratches. Ray picks about 23 percent winners at 7-2, but results may vary.
